Abstract	The Homestake Mining Company Thesis collection includes copies of several dozen theses either collected by or sent to various departments of the company. The dissertations date from 1920 through 1997.

Biographical/Historical Note

The Homestake Mining Company collected thesis papers that were related to the company's land holdings and mission. During the 1970s students often sent their thesis to the company in hopes of obtaining work after graduation. The Experimental Office of Homestake also ordered dissertations from various universities for the office's research library.

Scope and Contents Note

This collection contains copies of theses pertaining to the landholdings or the mission of the Homestake Mining Company. A majority of the dissertations were submitted to the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology, but the collection includes theses from a variety of colleges around the United States.
